- Energy statistics

- Draft and implement policies and legislation
- Prepare and run public tenders and issue licenses (one-stop shop)
- Oil and gas extraction

- Thermal power plants (incl. District heating)



## INFRASTRUCTURE, MARKETS AND REGULATION

- Draft and implement policies and legislation, regulatory oversight
- Power, heat, gas, hydrogen, CO2 and oil infrastructure
- Retail and wholesale markets for power and gas, district heating regulation
- Energy savings, labelling and product regulation

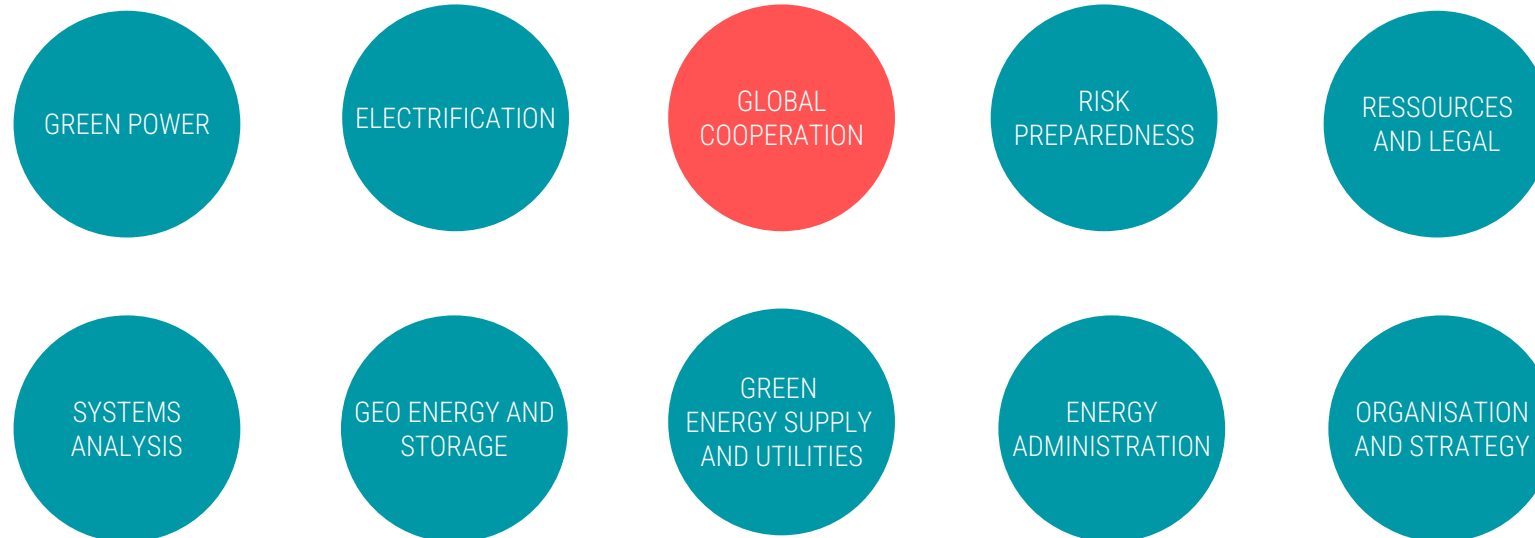

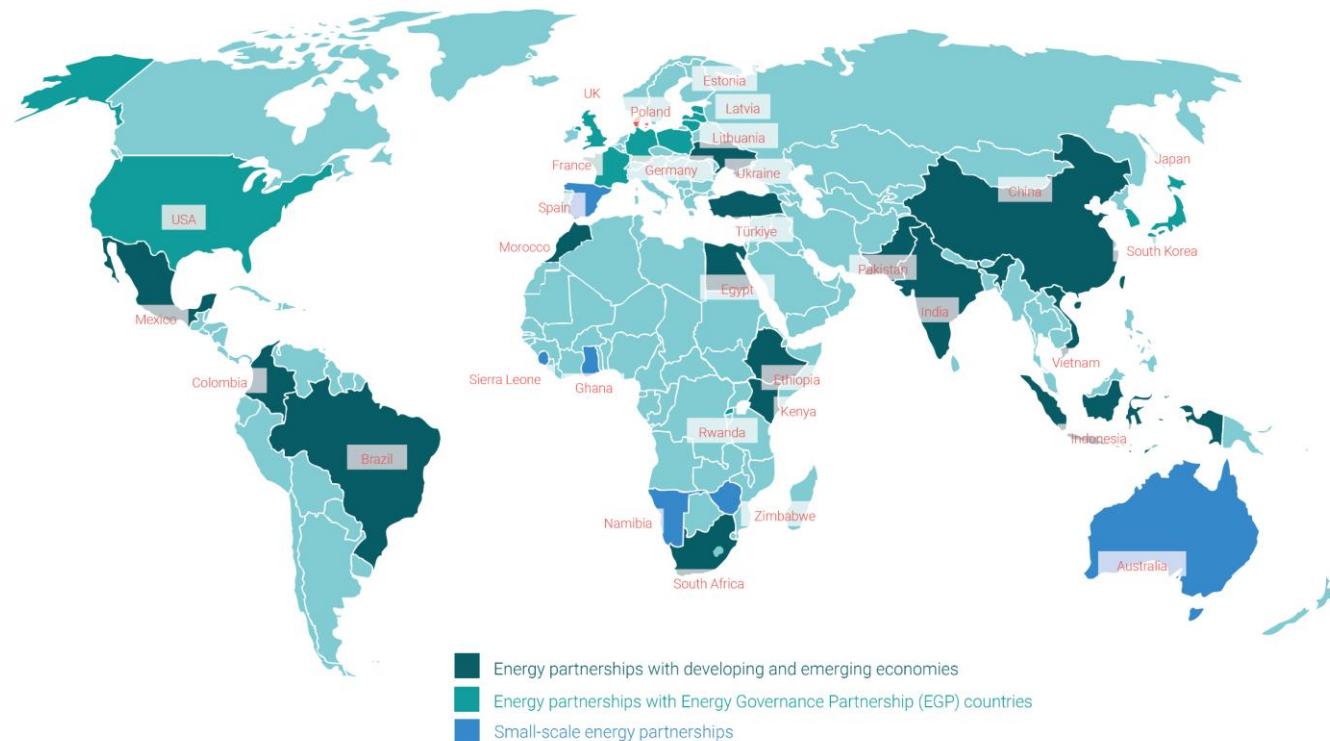

**Population:** ... represent **~61%** of the world's population

**CO<sub>2</sub> Emissions:** ... emit **~70%** of the global CO<sub>2</sub> emissions
